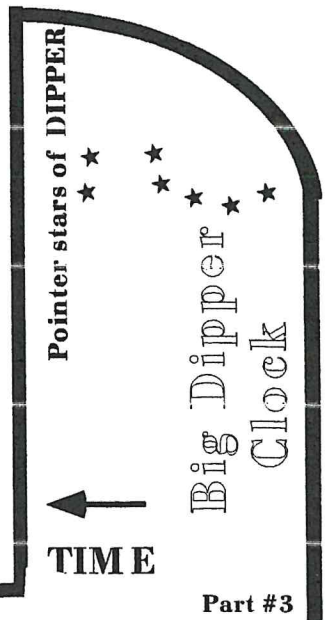
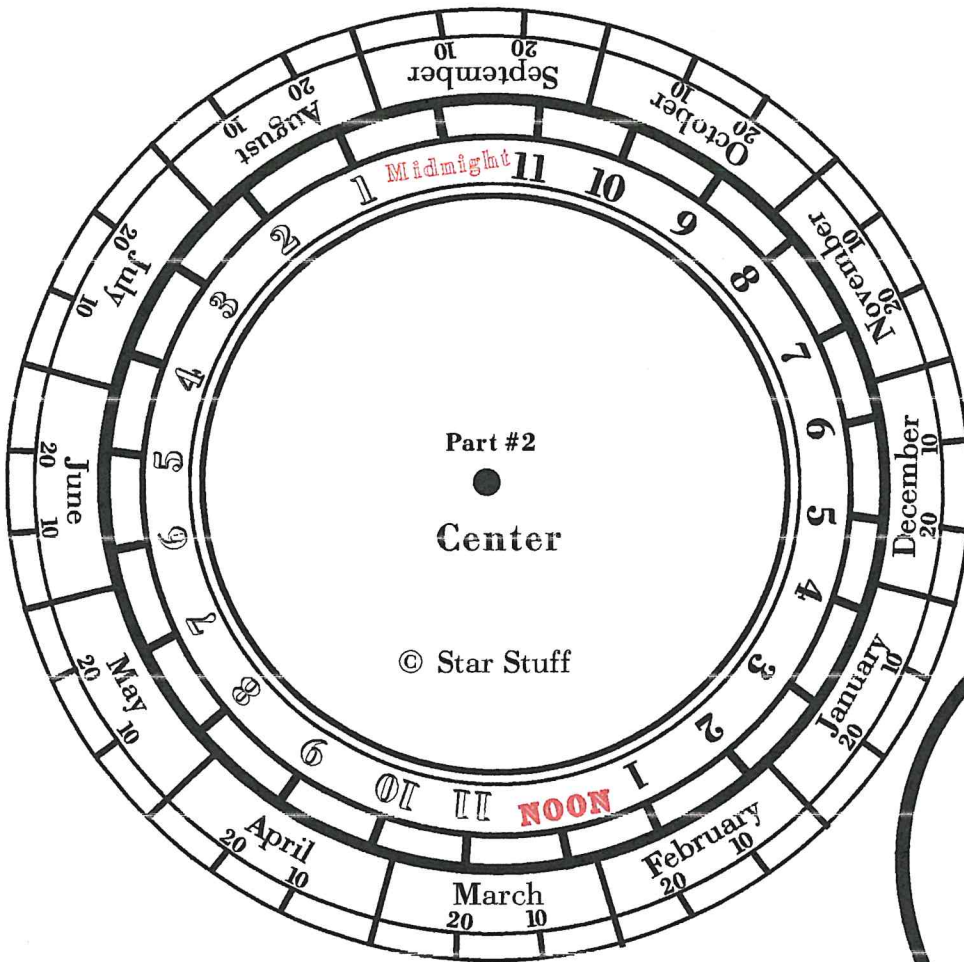


Big Dipper Clock



1. Point today's date on Part #2 to the DATE arrow on Part #1.
2. Point HORIZON arrows on Part #1 towards your horizon.

3. Point the center brass pin at Polaris (North Star).
4. Line up the Pointer Stars with the TIME arm (Part #3).
5. Read Time at pointer.

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1. Carefully cut out each section.
2. Punch a hole at the center mark of each section with a pointed tool.
3. Place the three sections on top of each other.

Part #1 is the bottom.
Part #3 is the top.



4. Insert a brass fastener through the center hole of each section starting with Part #3 on top.
5. Spin each section after folding out the feet of the fastener to insure smooth movement during time observations.

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
